## Neighborhood Watch

### “Signs of Life”

Greeting Neighbors, from your Neighborhood Watch. I am pleased to say that our program is well underway for keeping an eye on those among us who are living alone here in Beacon Terrace. I like to call the program, “Signs of Life”. We are placing signs in the windows of these neighbors that are Bright Green on one side, with a message, that says Good Morning, and Bright Orange on the other side with a message that says Good Night. These signs are checked twice a day for their presence and for the correct message for the time of day and/or the time of night, with a process to get in touch with the resident and confirm that they are ok, or get help for them if they do not respond if the sign is not in synch with the time of day. This program allows us to be aware of our neighbor’s well being at least twice a day by simply observing purposeful signs, that let us know you are here, and that you are ok. Please contact me if you are living alone, or if you have a neighbor you would like to see enrolled in the program.



# What's Cookin'



## Stuffed Green Pepper Soup

- 2 lbs. ground beef
- Italian Seasoning
- 1 T. garlic, minced
- 1 lg. onion, diced
- 2 lg. green peppers, diced
- 2 (14 1/2-oz.) cans diced tomatoes
- 2 (14 1/2-oz.) cans tomato sauce
- 1 (14 1/2-oz.) can beef broth
- 1 T. beef bouillon
- 2 T. Worcestershire sauce
- 1 tsp. salt (or to taste)
- 1 tsp. pepper (or to taste)
- 1 cup uncooked brown rice

In a large skillet, brown ground beef with a generous sprinkle of Italian seasoning and minced garlic. Add onion, green pepper, tomatoes with juice and tomato sauce. Add beef broth, bouillon, Worcestershire sauce, salt and pepper. Bring to a boil then reduce heat and simmer for an hour. Add rice and continue to simmer for another hour. Makes approximately 6-8 servings. Chuck Snavelly

## Sweet Potato Soup

- 2 large sweet potatoes
- 1 cup chicken broth
- ¼ cup orange juice
- ¼ tsp. salt
- ¼ tsp. ground nutmeg
- 1 cup milk

Heat enough water to cover sweet potatoes and bring to boiling in a 2 qt. saucepan. Add potatoes. Cover and bring to boiling, reduce heat and simmer 30-35 minutes or until tender, drain. Slip off skins, discard. Place potatoes in a blender or food processor. Add ½ cup of the broth. Cover and blend until smooth. Return blended mixture to saucepan. Stir in remaining broth, orange juice, salt and nutmeg. Cook over medium high heat stirring constantly, until hot. Stir in milk, cook until hot. 4 servings. Alice Murray
